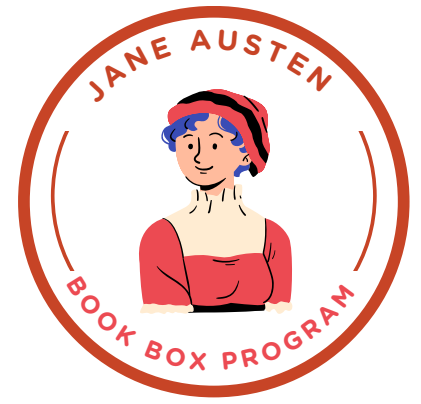


INTRODUCING: THE JANE AUSTEN BOOK BOX PROGRAM!
